

## OCULAR INVOLVEMENT IN EPIDERMOLYSIS BULLOSA

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Epidermolysis bullosa is a rare dermatologic disease of heterogeneous genetic disorder with different heritable mode. Some of the epidermolysis bullosa cases are acquired. It is characterized by blistering of the skin and mucosa following mild mechanical trauma. Ocular involvement in epider-

molysis bullosa had been reported, including recurrent corneal erosion, corneal opacity, eyelid ectropion, eyelid blister and symblepharon. We present two cases of epidermolysis bullosa, who suffered from corneal erosion, corneal opacity and eyelid lesions.

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
