

BREAST CARCINOMA WITH INTRAOCULAR AND INTRAORBITAL METASTASIS ---A CASE REPORT

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We report a case of breast carcinoma with both intraocular and intraorbital metastasis. A 76-year-old female was referred with left eyelid induration, motionless, ptosis and enophthalmos. She had been managed under the impression of eyelid chalazion at the local clinics for more than one year. She also suffered from right side breast cancer, received right

radical mastectomy about twenty years ago. Orbital CT revealed that tumor mass with intraocular and intraorbital extension. Tissue biopsy with immunohistochemical stains proved to be breast adenocarcinoma with high estrogen activity. Finally, she received local radiotherapy and oral hormone therapy.

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
