

**TRAUMATIC DISLOCATION OF
LENS INTO SUBCONJUCTIVAL SPACE
-- A CASE REPORT**

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A 75 years old male had injury to his left eye when falling down in the bathroom. Traumatic limbal laceration from 9 to 11 o'clock position with lens dislocation developed. He came to our OPD 3 months later due to decreased vision. The limbal wound had

healed with little uveal show, and no lens was found, but a subconjunctival mass was noted. The subconjunctival mass was removed during operation, and it was proved to be lens material pathologically.

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
