

CONJUNCTIVA REACTIVE LYMPHOID HYPERPLASIA -- A CASE REPORT

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We reported 2 cases of conjunctiva reactive lymphoid hyperplasia. The diagnosis was proved by excision biopsy in 2 cases. The 2 patients had similar clinical presentation, but respond well to different treatment modalities. And none of them had systemic

involvement. The first case responded well to cromolyn eyedrops. The second case resolved spontaneously after excision biopsy. No radiotherapy was needed, and their conditions were stable.

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
